NLTC Box League Rules

1. Matches will consist of as many games as can be played in a one hour booking slot. Players should be ready to go on the hour and ready to start after a strict 5 minute warm up.
2. Sudden death Deuce should be played with the receiver choosing which side to receive from.
3. One point will be awarded per game won. Only completed games will count. The score may go past the traditional set of 6, i.e. 8-2 but a match should not exceed one hour.
4. A bonus point will be awarded per match played.
5. Both players should each provide a set of good quality tennis balls.
6. Players have a **joint responsibility to organize matches** – please be proactive and follow court booking rules.
7. On the completion of a match, please enter the score on Google Docs or email the score to the coaching team who will update the boxes.
8. At the end of the round, the player with the most games win. The top three players in each group will move up and the bottom three players will move down to the group below. In the event of a tie, the head to head result between the tied players will decide. If more than two players are tied, the player with the highest percentage of games won to games played will move up.
